design problem: create an illustration for a pivotal scene in an assigned short story using digital photographs, scanned images, filters and drawing tools.

source material: Harrison Bergeron by Kurt Vonnegut, Jr. (1961, from Welcome to the Monkey House)

illustration specs: 7 x 9 inches, 220 dpi, full color

the illustration must incorporate:

(at least) 3 original, digital photographs

3 scanned, CD-Rom (stock) or corbis* images

3 filter effects

2 types of drawing tools

* no images may be downloaded from the internet unless they are from the corbis.com education site

week 2: 3 thumbnail ideas for different scenes from your assigned story


week 3: 6+ source photographs for the illustration

final illustration due week 4


the finished project includes:
