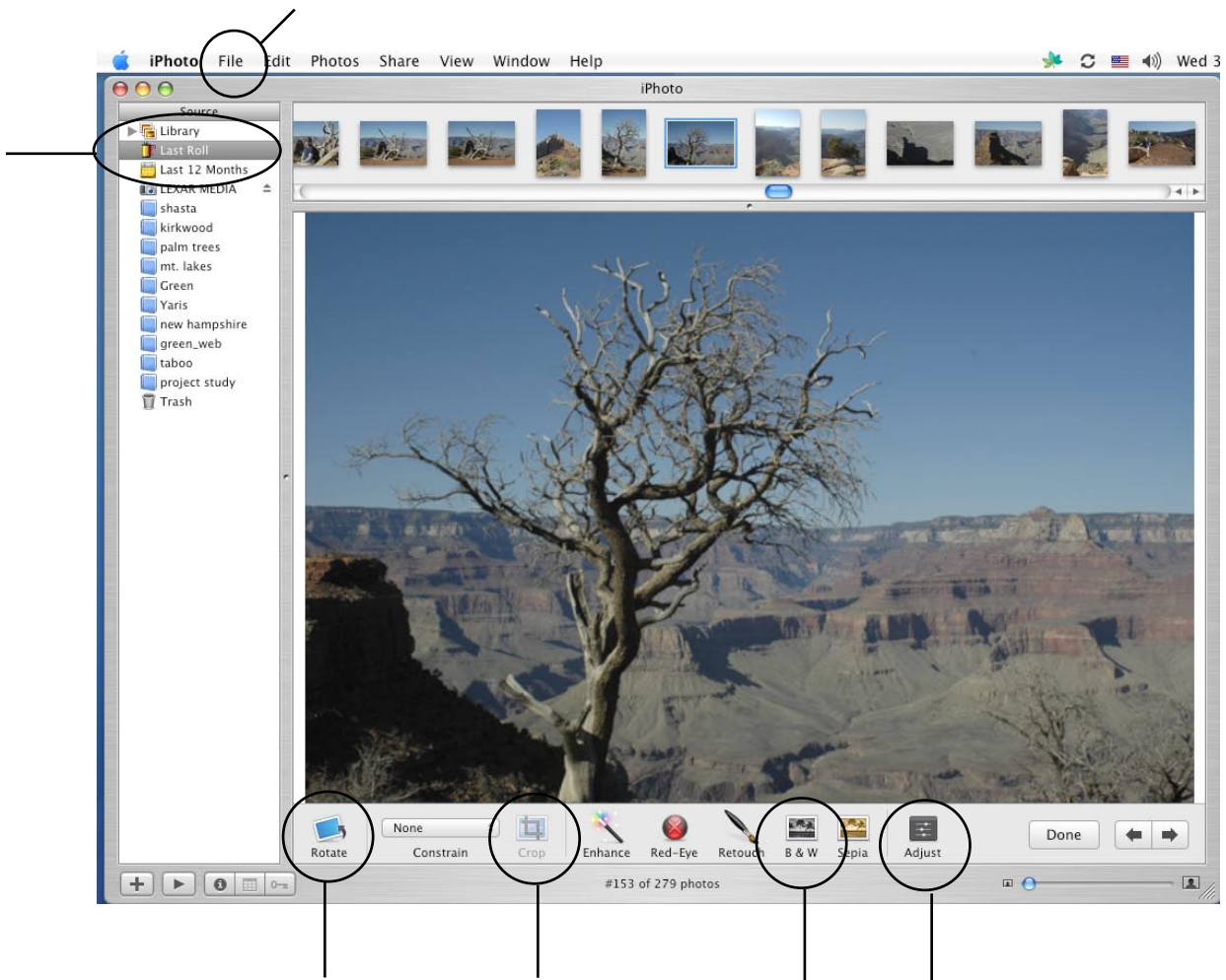
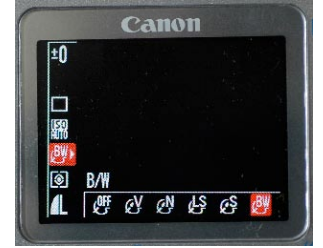
Set the mode

Contact Sheet Photoshop Basics

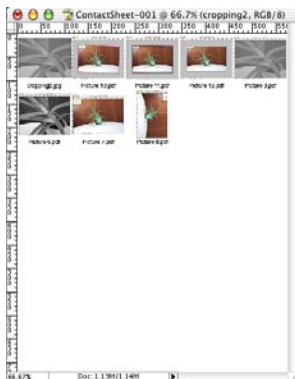
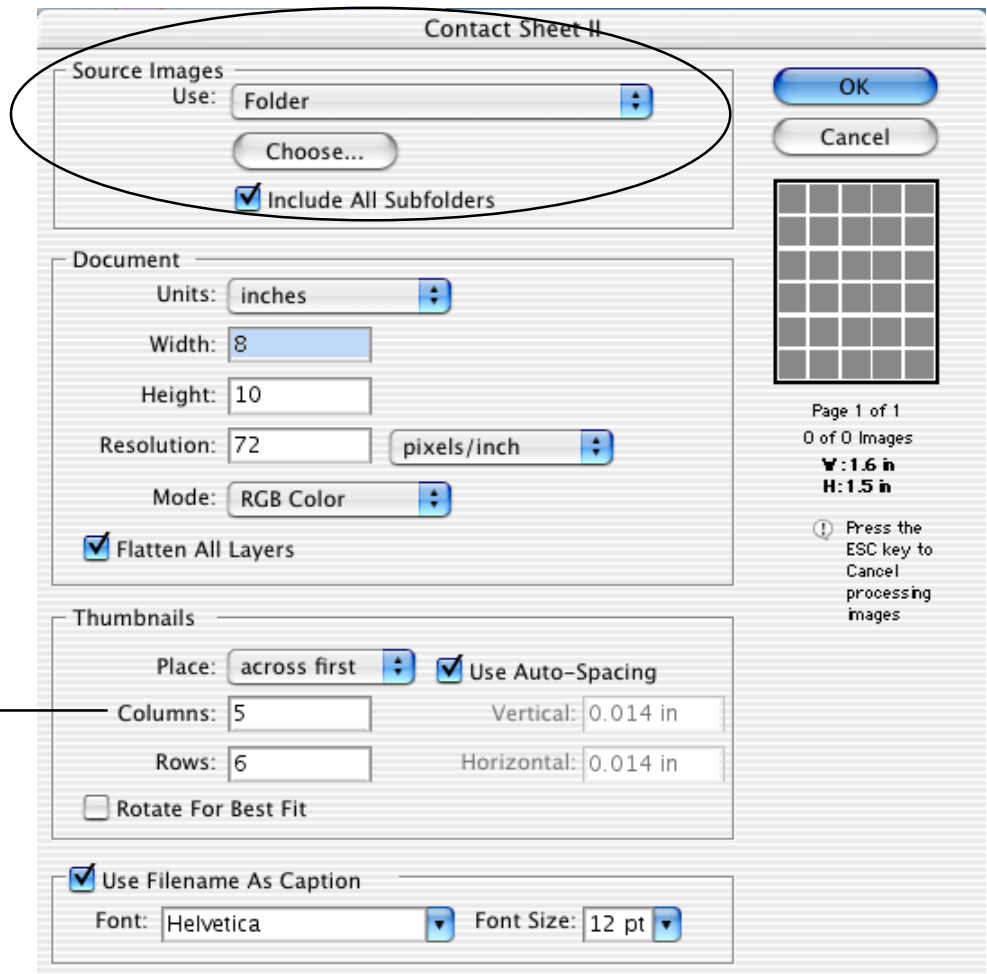
Prepare to make a contact sheet by creating a new folder and collecting all the photos for a particular assignment. [Select *file- new folder* then drag and drop the files]

Open Photoshop and select *file- automate- contact sheet II* to open the dialog box.

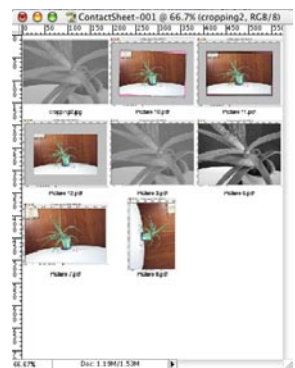
Select the folder under Source Images and adjust the options for the contact sheet.

Hit OK to run the action.

Check the results in Photoshop before saving and printing.



5 columns and 6 rows



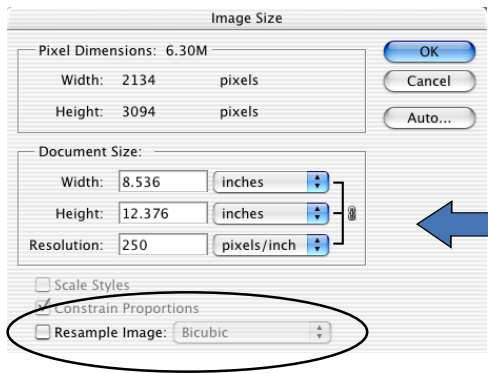
3 columns and 4 rows

Photo-Correction Photoshop Basics

Rotate Canvas [Image- Rotate Canvas- 90° CCW]



Change Resolution [Image- Image Size]



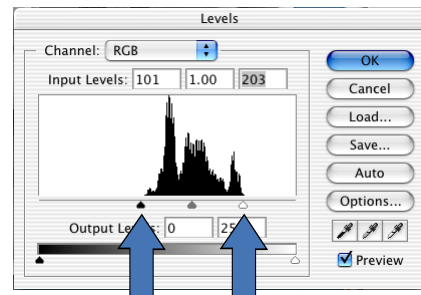
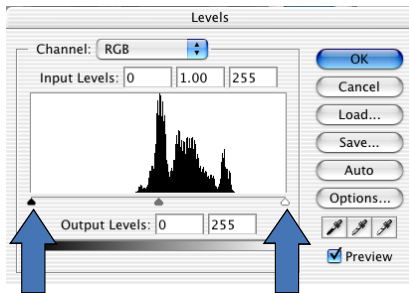
To resize for printing the **Resolution** should be between 200 and 300 pixels/ inch. Check the Width and Height also to make sure it will fit on the paper. Adjusting the resolution in the camera changes the overall size, not the ppi, so this must be adjusted before printing.

All the pixels that you need are already in the file, so uncheck the box that says Resample Image.

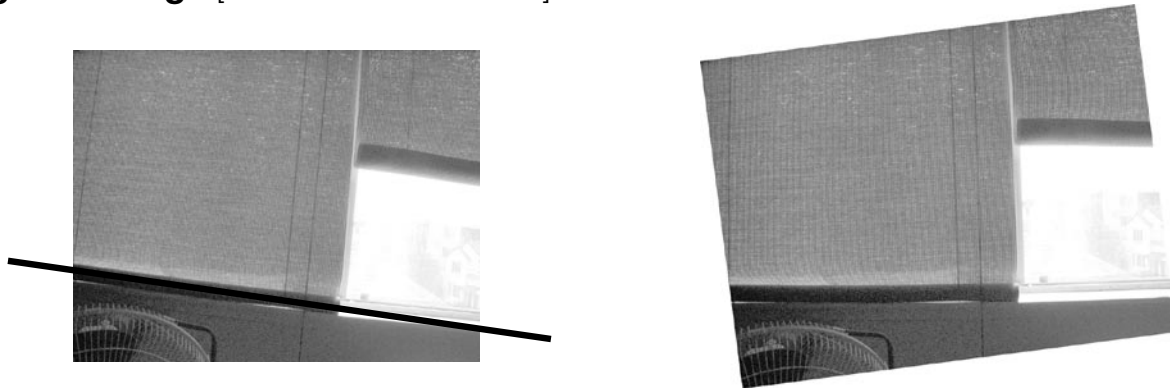
Select the entire photo [*Select- All*] or part of it using the Marquee Tool (**M**).

Adjust Contrast [Image- Adjustments- Levels]

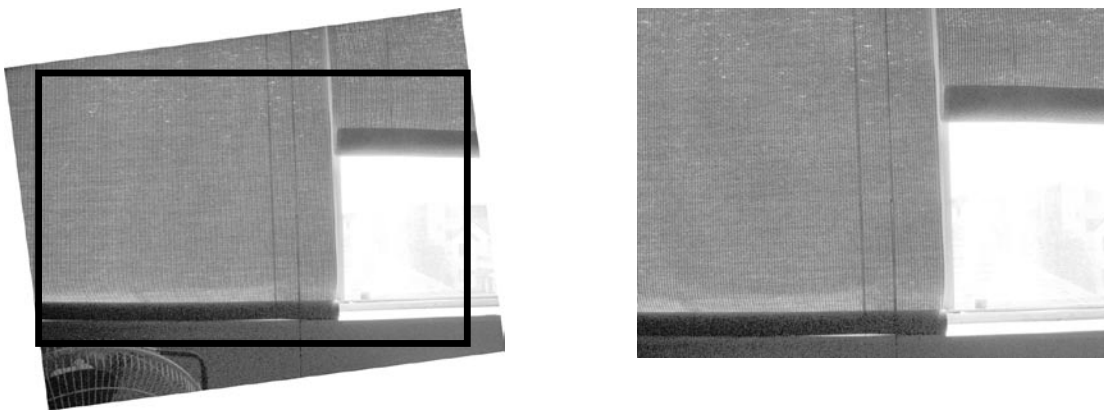
Adjust the contrast of your photo by sliding the black and white triangles in towards the center of the histogram. The photo should become less flat and have a fuller range of black, white and gray.



Straighten Image [Edit- Transform- Rotate]



Crop Canvas [Crop Tool C or Image- Crop after selecting]



Dodge and Burn [Dodge or Burn Tool O]
