

Advanced Image Manipulation: Creating a High Quality JPEG

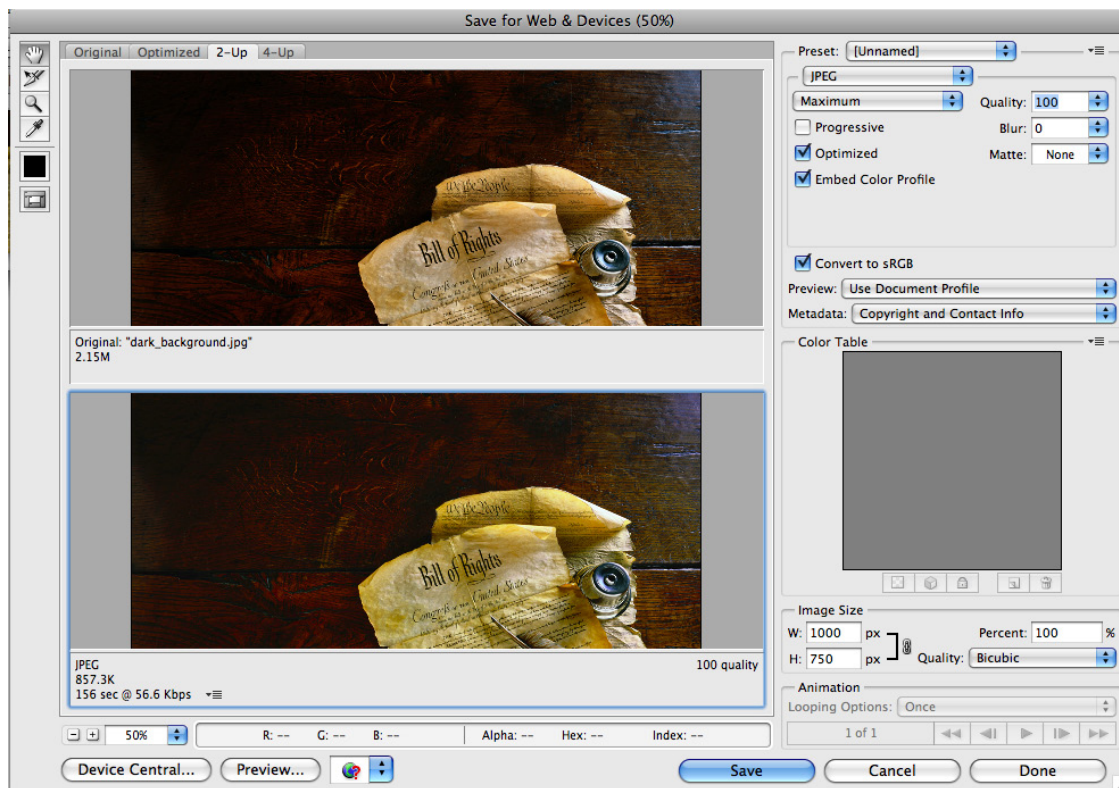
To save a file as a jpeg, either reduce the resolution manually to 72 dpi and Save-As, or follow the steps below.

Step One:

Flatten your file if it contains a lot of layers or is at a high resolution. Optimize is for saving images for the web and cannot convert images with larger file sizes.

Step Two:

Select File- Save for Web and Devices



At the top of the screen, select **2-up** to see both the original and the resized versions of your photo.

On the right, set the option to JPEG and choose high, medium or low (below) or move the quality slider to fine tune your resolution.

Below the photo is the new size and download time. Adjust the quality while looking at the results to get the best quality with the smallest file size.

To reduce file size, remove colors manually from the Color Table or change the Image Size by decreasing the pixel count or percent.
